LEGAL TEAM SIGNS UP

- At least 10 members of your legal team
- Lawyers, summer associates, paralegals, legal secretaries.
- No prior experience is required,
- No second language is required
- Legal team will pay a \$3,000 administrative fee
- Clinic lasts around seven hours

SJC ARRANGES CLIENTS

- *SJC hand-picks around 5 juvenile clients to participate*
- Each child requires legal guardianship to remain in the U.S.
- All children are eligible for Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS)

LEGAL TEAM GETS TRAINED!

- Volunteers are given 2-hour self-guided online training to complete
- CLE credit provided

TRAINING

- Self-guided online training covers the basics of SIJS and interviewing skills
- California attorneys get CLE credit

CLINIC BEGINS!

- Juveniles & their guardians join and are matched with volunteers and SJC interpreters
- Volunteers complete Guardianship and SIJS Petitions

REVIEW AND SIGN

 Volunteers review applications with clients & SJC attorney before clinic closes

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

- SJC attorneys provide technical assistance during clinic
- SJC reviews and approves all applications before they are signed

FILING PROCESS

- *SJC attorneys do final review and files Guardianship petition*
- SJC remains attorney of record
