SOCIAL JUSTICE COLLABORATIVE TO LAUNCH LEY VIDEO TOOLKIT FOR IMMIGRATION RAPID RESPONSE INITIATIVE

OAKLAND, CA – Social Justice Collaborative (SJC) is launching the LEY Video Toolkit, with beneficial resources for other legal services and nonprofit organizations, as well as for the general public in need of information about the immigration process and laws in California. The toolkit includes information about the process of applying for asylum, U-Visa eligibility, legal permanent residency, and immigration implications for criminal conviction. These resources are also translated in Spanish, Mam, and Cantonese—subtitles are also included. The LEY Video Toolkit was created by SJC staff and volunteers, which was made possible thanks to the support of the San Francisco Foundation’s Rapid Response Fund.

“This toolkit is extremely beneficial for immigrant communities and as part of our continuing commitment to represent them in immigration and criminal court,” said Gautam Jagannath, co-founder of SJC. “The toolkit includes information about eligibility for immigration benefits and other factors that will guide them throughout the immigration process.”

SJC’s toolkit will be accessible for legal services and nonprofit organizations in late February via email.
